

Band Booster Committee Descriptions

Band Camp - This committee sets out water/Gatorade in the mornings during band camp and supervises lunch time.

Banquet - This committee coordinates food and decorations for the band banquet in May.

Budget - This committee meets in the spring to work on the next year's budget for presentation to the executive board and membership.

Chaperone - This committee chaperones and recruits chaperones for travel and performances.

Chili Cook-Off / Trivia Night - This committee is part of the fundraising committee and runs the annual event.

Colorguard – Assists the guard director and band director in advancing the colorguard activity at LMHS, also serves as the liason to the executive board relative to colorguard operations.

Concessions - This committee oversees operations of the concession stand, stocking food items, and recruiting volunteers for the basketball, football, baseball, and track concession stands.

Construction - This committee builds sets or props for the band program.

Corporate Marketing – This committee works to procure corporate donations and sponsorships.

Equipment (Pit) Crew - This committee oversees and manages the loading, unloading, and transportation of band equipment and instruments. They also participate by moving equipment during competitions and games within the required set-up times.

First Aid – Assist with minor medical concerns during performance trips and when hosting contest.

Flag Sewing - This committee cuts and sews the color guard flags for competitions. You don't have to know how to sew to be a part of this committee.

Fundraising - This committee oversees current fundraisers and reviews prospective fundraisers for presentation to the board.

Grant Writing – This committee is part of the larger fundraising committee and oversees the procurement of grant funding for the LMHS Band program.

Hospitality – This committee hosts after-concert receptions and the hospitality room for judges and staff during the annual Louisville Classic Marching Band Contest.

Louisville Classic – This committee serves to plan and organize the annual marching contest day.

Public Relations - This committee is responsible for presenting information about the band and its accomplishments to the community.

Silent Auction - Committee secures donations and assists with operations for the annual auction.

Social Activities - This committee assists in arranging social events for the student membership.

Spirit Wear - This committee markets and distributes (staff approved) LMHS-branded spirit items.

Uniform - This committee fits uniforms, cleans uniforms, and readies the uniforms for performance for all of the marching band members. Sewing skill is not required. A few members of the committee also carry emergency kits at events to fix uniform problems and are allowed on the field.

Winter Percussion & Winterguard – These committees provide parent support for the winter activities.

Yearbook/Video - This committee collects and creates annual yearbook and/or memory video.
